During the pandemic and lockdown, he was searching for livelihood enhancement opportunities and through the I&IP program he worked as an online teacher in an International school teaching mathematics and science online to school students for a year.

Post pandemic he went through surgeries to enable him to move around easier to enable him to study and work towards becoming a doctor.
